Pesticide Label Layout Checklist

2. Name of pesticide (Trade Name)
3. Size of triangle (1/20 of the size of the whole label and it should be equilateral)
4. Colour of triangle-green, amber, red or purple
5. Registration Number
6. Pests controlled
7. Directions for use
8. Precautions
9. First Aid
10. Symptoms of poisoning
11. Antidote
12. Compatibility
13. Storage Conditions
14. Disposal Methods
15. Warranty
16. Date of Manufacture
17. Batch number
18. Expiry date
19. Composition (% or mass of active and inert ingredients)
20. Chemical Group
21. Weight/Net Content
22. Metrication/Application Rates
23. Pre-Harvest Interval (PHI)
24. Name and contact details of manufacturer
25. Name and contact details of distributor.
